

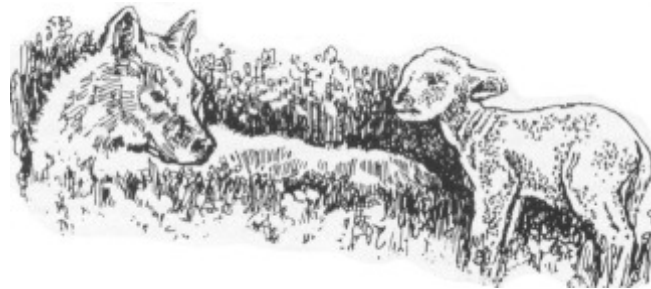

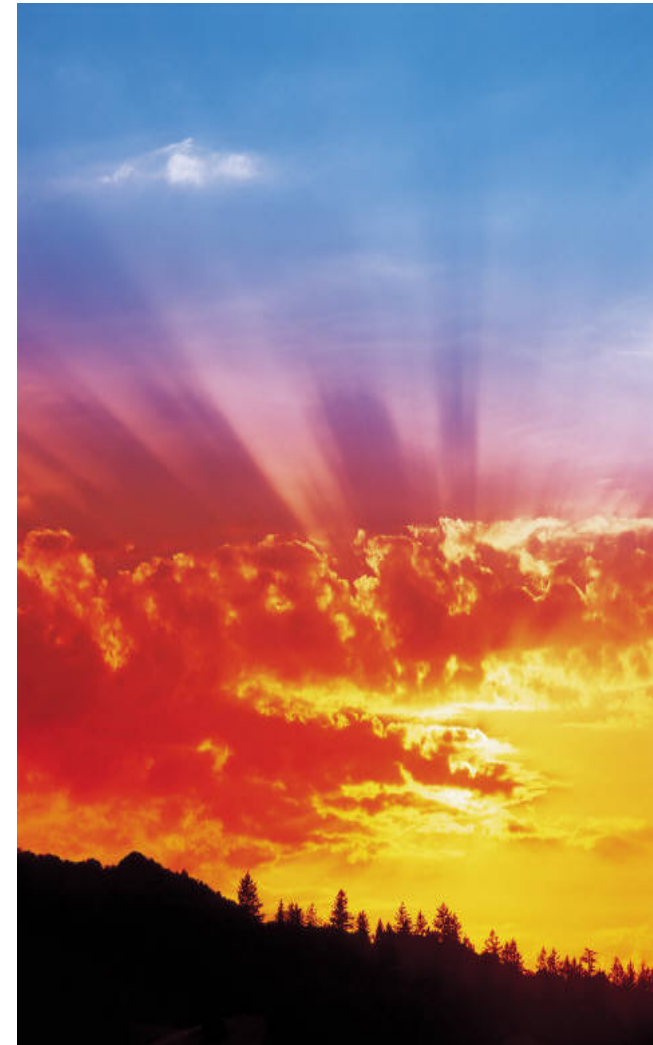

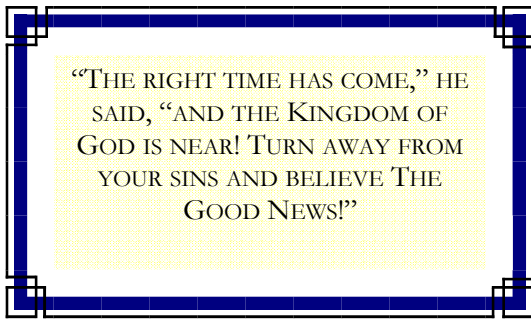

THE KINGDOM IS COMING

ARE YOU READY?





These are the first recorded words of Jesus (according to Mark). But what is the Kingdom of God and how does one enter it?

Jesus taught, "Blessed are the gentle, for they shall **inherit the earth**" (Matthew 5:5). He told the criminal who was crucified with him, "you shall be with me **in paradise**" (Luke 23:43). Revelation teaches, "You [Jesus] were slain, and purchased for God with your blood *men* from every tribe and tongue and people and nation. You have made them *to be* a **kingdom** and priests to our God; and they will reign **upon the earth.**" (Revelation 5:9&10).

God originally intended for mankind to be on the earth, righteous, peaceful, holy, and in perfect harmony with Him. By the time the Bible concludes and God's plan is complete, we again see the paradise of God restored and the New Jerusalem coming down **out of heaven** to the earth (Revelation 21:2). The tree of life is again featured as the centerpiece of paradise (Revelation 22:2).



It may shock you, but Jesus never preached that the faithful would go to heaven. Instead, he repeatedly said that they would "enter the kingdom" (Matthew 5:20; 7:21; Mark 9:47; 10:15; Luke 18:25; John 3:5). In fact, Jesus was **sent for the very purpose** of preaching the message of the Kingdom (Luke 4:43). In order to obey Jesus' first command, you must believe in this "kingdom of God" (Mark 1:14, and 15).

Jesus is coming back to be King over the whole earth (Psalm 2:8). He will resurrect the faithful and reign in righteousness. There will be no more war, suffering, or death. The earth will be totally renovated to be absolute paradise. God will wipe away the tears from His people. The ones who follow **King Jesus** will help him rule the world, and the wicked will be destroyed (Revelation 2:26; I Corinthians 6:2; Daniel 7:27).

"But when the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then **he will sit on his glorious throne.**

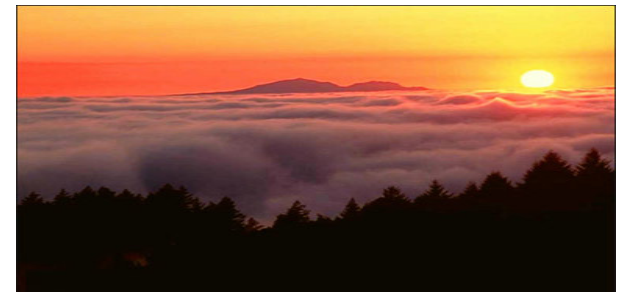
All the nations will be gathered before him; and he will separate them from one another, as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats...Then the **King** will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed of My Father, **inherit the kingdom** prepared for you from the foundation of the world.'

Would you like to enter this glorious coming Kingdom? You must acknowledge that the consequence of sin is death and realize that you need God's plan to pay for your sin through Jesus Christ (Romans 6:23). He has provided the escape route from mankind's inevitable road to destruction. Your old life can be erased and you can be a part of this bright future (II Corinthians 5:17). Believe that Jesus Christ died on the cross for your sins and was raised to life by God (Romans 10:9 and 10).



Now that you have accepted God's forgiveness, stop sinning, and begin to do what God says is right. Make Jesus the Lord of your life and follow his words, which serve as the directions to paradise. Jesus died for your sins. **Accept his work and follow his words.**
